CLASS I & II - Steel grey checkered half pant. White half shirt with school logo, Grey and Maroon striped tie. Grey belt with Maroon stripes, Grey socks with Maroon stripes, black shoes.

CLASS III & ABOVE- Silver black self checkered full pant, White half shirt with school logo, Grey and Maroon striped tie, Grey belt with Maroon stripes, Grey socks with Maroon stripes, black shoes.

WINTER UNIFORM

FOR BOYS & GIRLS (NUR-CLASS-II)- Silver black self-checked trousers, White full shirt with school logo, Melange Grey half sweater with Maroon Stripes, Melange Grey Full sweater with hood with Maroon stripes, Grey and Maroon striped tie, Grey belt with Maroon stripes, Grey socks with Maroon stripes, black shoes.

FOR GIRLS

CLASS - III & IV)- Silver black self checkered tunic, White full shirt with school logo, Melange Grey half sweater with Maroon Stripes, Light Worsted Grey Blazer, Grey and Maroon striped, tie, Grey belt with Maroon stripes, grey stockings, black shoes.

Summer: House T-shirt with track lowers, grey socks and black shoes (Nike) ; Boys (with lace) ; girls (with velcro)
