## A note of reminder to the parents:

### ● **Expectations relating to online classroom behavior.**

Parents are therefore requested to monitor their ward's online classroom behaviour to avoid misutilization of technology and gadgets.

### ● **Expectations relating to attendance & punctuality.**

We want all students to maximize the time they are with us so it is vital your child arrives at school on time. Also please think carefully about keeping your child out of school. Research shows that students who achieve the best results are also those children who have the highest school attendance.

### ● **Expectations relating to behavior**

At Loyola, we want to ensure students achieve their potential and take advantage of every opportunity that is on offer. We want all our students to ensure they are in the 'Right place at the right time doing the right thing' and that they conduct themselves in an appropriate way which we are referring to as having a 'mind to be kind'. We will encourage our students to make the right choices so they are able to stay in lessons and learn.

### ● **General expectations**

Since English is the medium of instruction in our school, you are requested to encourage your ward to speak in English at home and read English books and newspapers regularly. The school almanac must be checked by you daily. You are requested to monitor your ward's academic performance and also are expected to encourage him/her to take part in cultural and co-curricular activities so that the overall grades at the end of the academic session improve.

With the introduction of (**New Educational Policy 2020**), we envision an Indian-centric education system that directly contributes to transforming our nation sustainably into an equitable and vibrant knowledge base for the society by providing high-quality education to all. The new theme for the current academic era is **competency-based education & Skill based education**.
