Introduction to New Skill Subjects:

Important Points for Parents:

1. **Books and Copies:** All textbooks and notebooks must be properly covered and labelled with the child's name using a sticker.
2. **School Timetable:** Students should bring their books and copies to school as per the timetable.
3. **Almanac Signing:** parents must sign the school Almanac (Diary) daily. It serves as a communication tool between the school and parents allowing teachers to convey important information and track student progress
4. **Leave Application:** All leave application should be signed by the parents or guardians. It is necessary to obtain prior approval from the principal for long duration leave. Defaulter's absence may be recorded as unauthorised, affecting attendance records.
5. **School Diary Submission:** The first two pages of the school diary (almanac) should be filled and signed by the parents. This must be submitted to the class teacher within one week of the start of the academic session.

Together, we can ensure that each child receives the guidance and opportunities they need to succeed and develop into a confident, capable, and compassionate individual. We look forward to working with you in this journey of growth.
